


Here is the brief for Friday 23 July 2021.

Self-isolation exemption Changes are being made to self-isolation rules for close contacts of COVID cases to allow essential staff to return to work to maintain lifeline services and critical national infrastructure. The Scottish Government has outlined the process for applying for exemptions, highlighting that a different process will cover health & social care. We await further guidance from them about this and there will be more information shared in the brief next week.

For the time being, all NHS Grampian employees required to self-isolate as close contacts must continue to do so.

Grampian data Here is the local update for today, including the 7-day rolling positivity rate. As a reminder, this rate is arrived at by dividing the number of positive tests in the past 7 days by the number of tests carried out in the past 7 days. Repeat tests are included in both categories. The figure for the "daily number of new people tested" is only for the number of tests for people who have not been tested previously.



A national update is available on the Public Health Scotland daily dashboard.
